Preparatory workshop towards the International Nitrogen Management System

It has long been asked: "what would a science process to support international nitrogen policy development look like?" Such a process is now being developed as part of engagement between INI and the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) with the support of the Global Environment Facility (GEF) and many other partners and stakeholders.

A proposal for a full-sized GEF grant has been developed "Towards INMS" and is now undergoing its final review and endorsement stages. In principle, this means that the project may be ready to start towards the end of 2016. This will be a four year endeavour that among other things:

- Delivers a global assessment of nitrogen threats and benefits and opportunities for improving nitrogen management, including case studies for each of the main world regions.
- A forward look of what will happen if the nitrogen problem is ignored.
- Guidance on joining up mitigation and adaptation options and strategies, linked to circular economy and green economy thinking.
- A platform for better cooperation across nitrogen science and policy domains, helping to overcome the barriers.
